ANNEXURE A

Basic and Advance Level Notes

- **Basic Level Notes** are important for board examinations. The main focus has been on making conceptual clarity of concerned topic.
- **Advanced notes cater** to the need of Extra Syllabus specified in competitive examinations.

Question Series of Four Levels

Question bank based on four levels has been developed in the form of four stage game. These are (1) Basic level; (2) Level I; (3) Level II; and (4) Level III. The series of questions are designed on motivational Plan where student are given, set of questions, based on increasing level of difficulty.

- **Basic Level questions:** These are the questions which are frequently being asked into the board exams.
- **Level 1:** difficult questions from Board examinations.
- **Level 2:** important questions from competitive examinations like JEE Main, NEET.
- **Level 3:** questions from higher level competitive examinations like JEE Advanced, AIIMS and other national and international prestigious examinations.

All the above said stages of questions mostly comprise of fifty in number. Strengthening the concept of the topic is the major concern area.
