The Students from class 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will perform different activities on Water

Auditing like:-

- Use of water per day by individual and by whole family members.
- Activity can be done on amount of water being used for watering plants in the garden.
- Activity like difference in amount of water being used for washing of clothes by hand and by machine.

**For secondary and Higher Secondary students the activity performed should be based on theme calculation of Carbon foot print like:-**


- Calculating their ecological foot print and determining how many earths would be needed if everyone lived the same life style as they do so.
