Dear Sir/Madam,

1. The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been established by Ministry of Education, as an independent/autonomous, self-reliant and self-sustained premier testing organization.
2. NTA will be conducting the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE)-2021 for admission to Class VI and Class IX in 33 Sainik Schools across the country, for the academic year 2021-22, **on 07th February 2021 (Sunday) from 10.00 am to 1.00 PM.**
3. I take the opportunity to again write to you to seek your support for conduct of AISSEE 2021 to be held **on 07th February 2021 (Sunday).**
4. The list of cities where the exam will be held is enclosed. The list of Exam Centres and the number of candidates who will be appearing in the exam, from those Centres, City - Coordinators Observers, will be sent to you in the **last week of January 2020.**
5. The Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for the conduct of examination as finalised by the Government of India from time to time are to be implemented by all stakeholders, and the NTA on its part, has taken all measures to ensure implementation of the same on social distancing and other preventive/ protective measures at all the examination centres.
6. Advisories are being issued to the Examination Centres for adopting necessary precautions/safety measures in view of Covid-19. A copy of these Advisories is also attached for reference.
7. For the smooth conduct of this prestigious/high stake examination, you are requested to issue suitable Instructions to the concerned Department(s)/Authorities/District Administrations to extend necessary cooperation to the Exam Functionaries on the ground, including the following:
  - a) The Examination Centres in the Exam Cities in your State/UT should be allowed to open and operate for all activities before the exam, during the exam and after the exam on 07th February 2021 (Sunday).
  - b) Free movement may be facilitated in the Exam Cities in your State/UT between 06-08<sup>th</sup> February 2021 for the candidates and their escorts, Exam Personnel (Coordinator(s), Observers, Centre Superintendents, Deputy Centre Superintendents, Invigilators, Support Staff) for this exam.
  - c) In case there is a restriction on movements in certain areas, Admit Card/Identity Card of the candidates should be treated as a pass for their movement. In case of other functionaries, appropriate movement passes may be issued, if and when required.
  - d) In view of sensitivity of this examination and the necessity to maintain social distancing measures, the local district authorities (District Magistrate & Superintendent of Police) may be suitably advised to provide necessary administrative facilitation and security for conduct of this examination.
  - e) Adequate security arrangement may be made in the Exam Cities in your State/UT for maintaining Law and Order and Police Personnel (atleast 01 SI/ASI & 04 Constables) may be deployed at each Examination Centre, for crowd management and social distancing, in close coordination with respective City Coordinator(s)/Centre Superintendents.
  - f) It may be ensured that there is continuous power supply to the homes of candidates and to the exam centres.

I request you also to kindly direct the DM/DC/Local Authorities under your jurisdiction about the same.

I look forward to your support in the successful conduct of this examination.
