## PROGRAMME IN STATES/UNION TERRITORIES/ORGANISATIONS

1. The State Working Committees may obtain messages from the Governor, Chief Minister and State Education Minister and these may be given wide publicity.
2. Adequate arrangements may be made for necessary publicity through descriptive posters, cinema slides and advertisement in the press.
3. Sale of tokens and car flags are the most effective way of collecting funds. The designs of the token and car flags may remain the same as in the past except for change in the year and these may be got printed by the respective States/UTs Working Committees if the State Foundation for Teachers' Welfare.
4. The State Governments/UTs may consider bringing together on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2016 some selected teachers (specially from rural areas) of their States/UTs to discuss different aspects in education and also the role of teachers to meet the new demands of education.
5. Different organizations including educational institutions may organize special functions to honour the teachers and also organize talks, symposia etc. to bring out the key role of the teachers as the builders of the coming generation.
6. Cultural organizations as well as other related organizations in educational institutions may be requested to organize special entertainment programmes one or two days before Teachers' Day. The receipts realized may be credited to the corpus of the National Foundation for Teachers' Welfare. Such receipts may be granted exemption from the payment of entertainment tax. Certain cultural programmes may be arranged wherein any celebrity can be invited.
7. Cinema owners/exhibitors in the States/UTs may be requested to donate the earnings of one show on the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2016 to the National Foundation for Teachers' Welfare. It is hoped that the cinema house owners will respond in a big way to an appeal from the State Government/UT Administration concerned. Such shows may also be exempted from the payment of entertainment tax.
8. Programmes like athletic meets, friendly cricket matches and football matches etc. may be organized to raise funds for the Foundation. Ministers, teachers and students may be invited to take part in these matches.
9. The donations are to be entirely voluntary and the donors should be free to contribute any amount they like. The donation may be collected in the usual collection boxes. The State Government/UT Administration can also make other appropriate arrangements. The collection may be organized under the supervision and guidance of responsible persons through credited volunteers. Precautions may be taken to prevent misuse of the collections as well as distribution of the flags by unauthorized persons. Adequate numbers of flags may also be made available to the educational institutions situated in the State/UT. 10% of these collections may be sent to the Foundation for the welfare of teachers.
10. The local stations of All India Radio and Doordarshan may be requested to cover the Teachers' Day programme all over the country especially in rural areas.
11. The industrial establishments/industrialists may be involved to contribute/donate generously to the corpus of the Foundation.
