Sir,

As you are aware, World Environment Day (WED) is celebrated every year on June 5th with active involvement of students, teachers, National Green Corps (Eco-clubs), NGOs, district Administration and Municipal Councils/Corporation. The UNEP decided theme of WED-2019 is "Air Pollution". The celebration aims to inspire more people to do something about the quality of air that we breathe.

Approximately 7 million people world wide die prematurely each year from air pollution. World Environment Day 2019 will urge Government, Industries, communities and individuals to come together to explore renewable energy and green technologies and improve air quality in cities and regions across the world.

The World Environment Day may be celebrated in the district under your able guidance. Various activities may be organized at district, sub division, block and tehsil headquarters with the active cooperation and participation of local bodies, Panchayats, NGC [ECO-Clubs], NGO's, youth, social organisations and educational institutions. Cleanliness campaigns may also be organized in the urban centers. 
- Oath to be taken on "Say No open burning" of leaves and other material.
