Enclosed herewith please find the report of 10th class result of National Achievement Survey conducted by NCERT dated on 5th February, 2018. The Average Achievement of the State in four subjects in comparison to National Average is low. Moreover the percentages of Matriculation Board results of 10th have also come down in session 2017-18. to 63.39% as compared to 67.57% in 2016-17 whereas in +2 it has come down from 72.89% in 2016-17 to 70.18% in 2017-18. Continuous Poor performance of the students has been a big concern of the state government.

All the Stake holders are hereby directed to take timely measures to improve the performance of the students in various examinations and surveys. Following steps are desired to be integrated into the school processes by all the heads and teachers:


- Identify the poor performers of all the classes and put in extra efforts by organising remedial classes in a team effort.
- Mentoring of teachers/students.
- Changing classroom processes by adopting Child Centered Approach by means of providing more opportunity to students to express their thoughts and knowledge in building up new knowledge based on previous experiences.
- To enhance the higher order skills of understanding and application of knowledge.
- Adopting small action research based study into the classes by assigning the projects on different topics (grammatical items /character writing of different set of personalities/map work/environmental sciences/ making tables/charts/environmental sciences etc.) Findings of the Projects based upon action researches of the topics having implication in their surrounding/environment. Students will prepare projects after
 - Identifying problems from science and Maths, English, Social Science
 - Preparing hypothesis.
 - Action plans.
 - Collecting and interpreting data based on the observation and
 - Drawing out the conclusion.
- Explaining models/ practical of various concepts prepared with their own hands which give them real understanding of concepts and leads to lifelong learning.
- Subject and class wise Quiz competitions

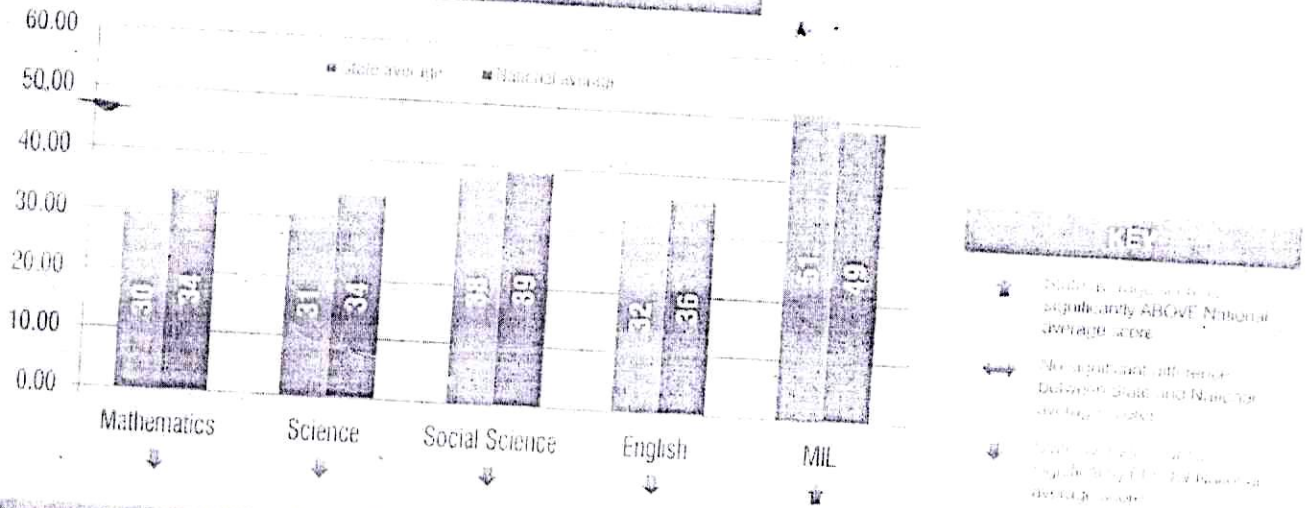
