**Subject:** Construction of Rain Water Harvesting Tank in Govt. Schools  
situated in rural areas of HP.

Sir,

It is informed that with the objective of "Conservation of Water" the Board is contemplating to construct "Rain water harvesting Tank" with capacity of 10,000 Ltrs. in the Government schools (High and Senior Secondary) located in rural areas of Himachal Pradesh in collaboration with Department of Rural Development, so that the drinking water may be conserved and rain water can be used in sanitation, horticultural other agricultural activities in the schools. Department of Rural Development constructs the Rain Water Harvesting Tanks in the Schools located in Rural areas only under MGNREGA scheme through resolution passed in concerned Gram Panchayat.

There is a feedback that "Rain Water Harvesting Structures" already exist in some schools. You are, therefore, requested to supply the list of schools (excluding those schools with rain water harvesting structures) of your district with availability of adequate space to us at the earliest so that the work could be initiated accordingly.
