Dear Sh. Sandeep,

I would like to bring to your kind notice that even though the overall saturation of District is more than 100 % but population in the age group of 0-5 years is yet to be covered. There are approximately 1000 children yet to be covered. As per the Aadhaar Act, mandatory biometric updation of children is to be carried out once the child attain the age of 5 years and 15 years else Aadhaar can be suspended. In addition to this lot of public complaints are being received regarding overcharging, rejection of enrolment due to non-adherence to the UIDAI procedures etc. In view of this it is desired that:

1. Regular inspections of the Aadhaar centers working in district should be done . It must be ensured that UIDAI approved list and list of Proof of identity (POI) and Proof of Address (POA) is displayed at the centers. UIDAI complaint number 1947 and mail id help@uidai.gov.in should also be displayed at all the Aadhaar Enrolment centers. For the convenience of Public kindly display the list of Aadhaar enrolment centers working in Bank Branches, Post offices and at other govt. buildings in Prominent places of public dealing & in Lok-Mitras. Regular press release indicating the details of the enrolment centers functional in your district would be very helpful in dissemination of information to the public.
2. Department of Health is facilitating enrolment of new born children at the time of birth in hospitals itself under Aadhaar linked Birth Registration programme (ALBR). 03 number of Tablets were provided to your district .All private and Govt. Birth units may be covered by utilizing the Tablets.
3. To cover the population in age group 0-5 year, Department of WCD has procured 78 Tablets and 156 ECMP Kits out of which **10 ECMP Kits and 5 tablets being deployed in CDPO blocks in Una district.** To make these kits and Tablets operational 15 Aanganwari workers and Supervisor were trained in the district. All the kits should be made functional . UIDAI has authorized IPPB (India Post Payment Bank) to start the Aadhaar enrolment of children in the age group of 0-5 years .

4. In Schools, mandatory biometric Updation of children is to be carried out on attaining the age of 5 & 15 years. At present about 5.5 lakh students have been identified for mandatory biometric update in Himachal Pradesh. Out of which about 46000 Pertains to District Una. For this, the schools should be mapped with the nearest Aadhaar Enrolment Centre. The list of Centers in your district is available at <https://appointments.uidai.gov.in/easearchinternal.aspx>
5. LDM/Senior Supdt. of Post/Nodal officers at district level need to institutionalize regular inspection mechanism to ensure proper functioning of Aadhaar Enrolment centers in banks/post office and Govt. buildings respectively. Further before the lockdown 46 kits were working in the district, however as on date 42 kits are working. Pendency is of DIT (3) and DHS(1). Concerned nodal officer of District may be asked to make all the kits fully functional.

I am to refer to DO letter No. UIDAI/RO/CHD/HP/2019/5561 dated 27-12-2019 received from Bhawana Garg, IAS Dy. Director General, UIDAI, RO. Chandigarh on the subject cited above.

In this regard, it is to inform you that as per Annexure-II attached with the DO letter, there are 40 Enrolment Centres (ECs) working under different Enrolment Agencies(EAs)in this district. The EA of first 15ECs (Sr.No.1 to Sr.No.15) is Director of IT, Himachal Pradesh, next 15ECs (Sr. No. 16 to Sr. No. 30) is of Department of Post, Circle Shimla and EA of last 10ECs (Sr.No.30 to Sr. No. 40) is different Banking Agencies.

To reduce public grievances about Aadhaar, Govt. considered that the inspection of these centres is one of the tool. You are, therefore, requested to inspect at least 5 ECs fall under your jurisdiction every month as per following programme and send the inspection report on the prescribed format to UIDAI as well as to your respective State Registrar under intimation to this office by 5th of every month without failing.


