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MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON "PROMOTION OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT (HRD) RELATED ACTIVITIES, EXCHANGE OF KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS FROM STUDENTS OF URBAN AREAS TO STUDENTS/ YOUTHS/PUBLIC OF BORDER VILLAGES UNDER THE BADP" HELD ON 21.03/2017 AT 03.00 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY, ASSAM.

Members present at Annexure 'A'

On 21/03/2017 at 3 PM a meeting was held in the Conference Hall of the Chief Secretary, Assam to discuss on the aspect of exchange of knowledge / skills from students of Urban Areas to students/youths/public of border villages as part of Human Resources Development (HRD) under education/capacity building programme and activities in sports. The meeting was held in compliance of the directive of Ministry of Home Affairs (Department of Border Management) that the State Govt should consider organising tours/visits for students of Urban areas to border villages and their home stay therein, under the Border Areas Development Programme (BADP).

The Chief Secretary presided over the meeting and the members present actively participated in the deliberation. After threadbare discussion, the following decisions were taken.

- (1) It was unanimously agreed that this programme for promotion of HRD related activities, exchange of knowledge skills from students of urban areas to students, youths of border villages under BADP would be named as Simanta Gyan Aahoran Asoni, and all endeavours would be made to make the programme a success.
- (2) The programme for exchange of knowledge/skills from students of urban areas to youths /students of border village will be taken under BADP by the Border Areas Department. The programme may be funded from the Contingency Fund of BADP under the disposal of the Chief Secretary.
- (3) The Border Areas Department will chalk out a detailed plan for the programme and prepare a broad guideline in this regard.
- (4) It was decided that 800 students from Urban areas will be identified first for the proposed visit and home stay in the border villages. The term "urban areas" will cover all towns & cities of Assam irrespective of their locations whether in border or otherwise. The Education Department (Secondary/Higher) will take necessary action for selection of students and arrangement of the tours/visits etc. They will also indicate the tentative dates taking into account the academic calendar of the Schools/Colleges/Universities.
- (5) Only the students from Class IX onwards to degree students will be eligible for taking up the tour/visits to the border villages.
