Subject: To Execute First Term Examinations in Secondary and Senior Secondary Classes.

Sir,

As per the direction of Government of Himachal Pradesh, the first term examinations for classes 9-12 are to be conducted in first week of September. Please find the details to conduct the exams as under:

- The mode to conduct First Term I will be through online in case the school closure continues and offline if the schools reopen for selected classes.
- Following procedure will be followed in case the exams are conducted in the schools in the physical presence of the students of selected classes :
 - ✓ Password protected PDF locked files will be uploaded on the Har Ghar Pathshala website on or before 28th of August.
 - ✓ The Deputy Directors of Higher Education will share the password after 28th August with the School Heads, who will be responsible for printing the question papers as per requirement of the school.
 - ✓ Decisions regarding printing, execution of the assessments, checking of assessment sheets etc. Of the areas having no net facility, or regarding the students who are not connected with Har Ghar pathshala, will entirely be taken by the Heads of such schools.
- In case of online exams, each day, the passwords to the PDF question papers will be shared through the daily WhatsApp message. Teachers will forward these to concerned students.
- The duration of the examination will be 3 hours.
- The ratio of Multiple Choice Questions and Subjective questions will be in the percentage of 40:60.
- In online exams, students will attempt the question paper in the given time and send an image of the answer sheet via WhatsApp to the teacher on same day.
- At the end of all exams, physical answer sheets are to be submitted into the schools, by parents/students, to be marked by the teachers.
- Academic calendar of Term I Syllabus has already been prepared at the start of the academic year and is uploaded on the site of Har Ghar Pathshala.
