I would like to mention that the Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad Foundation and MAER's MIT School of Government, Pune have taken initiative to bring together students from across the Country in an Annual Conclave called Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad (Indian Student Parliament). Seven such annual events have already been organized with great success and the 8th Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad is being organized during January 19-21, 2018. The basic objective of organizing this Conclave is to effectively involve the youth in the democratic process of the Country. The Event gets support/ participation from international agencies like UN, UNESCO, SAARC, Inter-Parliamentary Union, etc.

2. This is a non-partisan and apolitical Event, where deliberations are held on issues of contemporary significance. During last seven years several eminent personalities have addressed the conclave like: Late A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Anna Hazare, Mohan Bhagwat, Dalai Lama, Dada J. P. Vaswani, Sri Ravi Shankar, Maulana Mahmood Madani, K. Natwar Singh N. Chandra Babu Naidu, M. Venkaiah Naidu, Nitin Gadkari, Kiran Bedi, L. K. Advani, Leander Paes, Morari Bapu, Margaret Alva, N. R. Narayana Murthy, Muhammad Yunus, Omar Abdullah, Shabana Azmi, Subramanian Swamy, Lobsang Sangay, Ustad Zakir Hussain, Swaminathan Gurumurthy etc. in addition to these several eminent personalities like Aung San Suu Kyi, Irina Bokova, Malala Yousafzai, Sunita Williams etc., addressed the Conclave through pre-recorded video message.

3. During the eighth Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad to be held during 19-21 January, 2018, deliberation will take place on a number of important subjects like (i) The Triumph of Trump; Where does India stand? (ii) Triple Talaq; The Drama and Discontents (iii) Casteism in Indian Democracy; Problems & Prospects (iv) GDP (Gross Domestic Product) Vs. GDH (Gross Domestic Happiness) (v) Be Mature; Save Nature (vi) Satyagraha; 100 Years of Mahatma in India, etc. A number of eminent speakers are expected to speak on the occasion.
