Dear District Collector/Magistrate,

This is in context of "Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration". My earlier DO letter dated 02.09.2016 (copy enclosed) may be referred to in this regard.

2. The process of registration of Districts/Mandis for choosing the priority programme is in progress on PM Awards portal. Districts may choose one or more of the priority programme except "Start Up India" for competing in Prime Minister's Awards Scheme".

3. The pdf format of Application forms for the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration have been uploaded on PM Award Portal (link is available on our website darp.gov.in), so that Districts/ Mandis can prepare themselves for applying

4. I appreciate that majority of Districts have registered and chosen priority programmes. However, some of the Districts have registered themselves but have not chosen any priority programme. It is expected that such Districts will chose priority programmes at the earliest.

5. Those Districts / Mandis, which have not registered on portal till date, shall also have an opportunity to register themselves, chose priority programme and submit online application till last date of submission.

6. In addition to Awards in Priority Programme, Awards will also be given for Innovations in the field of environment conservation, disaster management, water conservation, energy, education and health, women and child centric initiatives etc. Apart from Organisations of Central / State Governments, District organisations are eligible for PM's Award for Innovations.

7. Online submission of Application for PM Awards for both kinds of awards shall start from 01.01.2017 and the last date for submission of application is 14.01.2017. All the Districts are requested to apply for the Prime Minister's Awards for Priority Programmes by submitting online application on Prime Minister's Awards portal. Districts may also apply for 'Innovation' category and showcase the path breaking, high impact and innovative initiatives taken.

Dear District Collector/Magistrate,

Government of India has instituted 'Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration' to acknowledge and recognize the extraordinary and innovative work done by Districts and Central/State Governments organizations. Copy of the scheme is available on DARPG website i.e. [www.darpg.gov.in](http://www.darpg.gov.in)

2. The awards are given for excellence in implementing priority programme of Government of India. For the year 2017, following Priority Programme have been chosen (i) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (ii) Deendayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojna (iii) Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (iv) Start Up India/Stand Up India (v) e-National Agriculture Market (National e-Mandi)

3. Districts/implementing units are eligible to apply for Excellence in implementing the identified Priority Programmes. The period of consideration of award is April, 2015 to December, 2016. It is expected that each district shall choose at least one programme from the identified priority programme for competing under this scheme. However, districts may choose as many programmes as they can from amongst the identified priority programme so that there can be wider participation. Since, the period of consideration for implementing priority programme is up to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2016, it is expected that districts will make use of time available to upgrade implementation of priority programmes in a competitive spirit and show tangible results in implementation of priority programmes. The applications for the awards shall be received online from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2017 in the format to be communicated in due course.

4. Awards to the selected districts/organization will be presented on next Civil Services Day i.e. 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2017. We expect that the Scheme would generate greater enthusiasm and wider participation this year.
