Subject: - Development of School Nutrition Garden under Mid Day Meal Scheme.

Sir,

In continuation of this Directorate letter of even No: Dated 20.06.2019 vide which detailed guidelines have been circulated to you for the development of school nutrition garden in the school premises both in rural and urban areas irrespective of availability of land under mid day meal scheme. In this context, it is once again re-iterated that in pursuance of the GOI, MHRD guidelines of school nutrition garden maybe developed in all the schools and plants may be grown in the small containers, cans, jars, discarded earthen pots, wooden peti, ceramic sinks, food tins, and atta bags etc where land is not available. Large piece of land is not required for growing vegetables. Even roof tops can be used for growing vegetables/ fruits in containers.

For this purpose, the school have to make efforts to grow local vegetables and fruits etc in these school nutrition garden, so that the green and fresh local vegetables and fruits of these school Nutrition garden could be used in the mid day meal to provide the nutritious food to the students under mid day meal scheme and the amount so saved against the purchasing of these vegetables.

In view of the above, you are directed to furnish the action taken report on the prescribed Performa attached at annexure-I on or before 31.08.2019 alongwith e-photographs of the school nutrition gardens to this Directorate, so that the matter could be processed further with the GOI, MHRD New Delhi for seeking requisite funds for the above said purpose.
