



**Suggestive Day Wise Activities for Special Sanitation Drive are as under :**

<b>Date</b>	<b>Theme Suggested</b>	<b>Activities</b>
14th November 2018	<b>Community Mobilization Day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Block level launch of Special Sanitation Drive should also be done by respective SDMs/ BDOs with the support of all line departments and if possible, local MLA or other dignitaries may also be called.</li> <li>* All the VWSCs, Mahila Mandals, Yuvak Mandals, SHGs and other Community Based Organizations will be involved in awareness campaign.</li> <li>* Effective mechanism for SLWM activities will be established in the GPs.</li> <li>* Awareness camps will be organized by Agriculture Department for promoting the concept of composting and vermin composting.</li> <li>* Soak pits for house hold liquid waste will be constructed at each household level. The technical staff working at GP/Block level will be asked to promote proper design of low cost soak Pits.</li> <li>* Cleanliness drive will be initiated by each household in and around their houses.</li> <li>* Sensitization of local market people regarding sanitation and waste management issues will be taken up by the GPs/VWSCs.</li> </ul>
15th November 2018	<b>General Cleanliness Day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Rallies by the Mahila Mandals, Yuvak Mandals, SHGs etc.</li> <li>* General Cleanliness of the office premises at District , Block and Field level offices and removing of posters etc from the public places and Govt. Buildings.</li> <li>* Cleaning the house premises to ensure that there is no accumulated waste water or solid waste in the house premises or in the vicinity.</li> <li>* Clearing of weeds, bushes and plastic waste.</li> <li>* To channel waste water from kitchen and bathroom proper drains should be made and if required maintenance work should be carried out.</li> <li>* Cleaning of household toilets.</li> <li>* Message on making the village open defecation free would be stressed upon by the volunteers along with monitoring the physical activities of cleaning the household.</li> <li>* Repairing cattle shed, managers, drains to ensure proper and safe disposal of animal urine and excreta should be ensured.</li> <li>* To ensure the cow dung to not litter, a pit for composing may be emphasized upon.</li> </ul>

16th November 2018	<b>School &amp; Anganwadies Cleanliness day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* During this Day the GPs will be asked to organize medical check-up (involvement of VWSC) for all the registered mothers infants and small children who will be given talks on personal health and hygiene issues along with safe hand washing.</li> <li>* The Anganwadi Workers will organize door-to-door awareness campaign on sanitation with special focus on safe disposal of child faeces.</li> <li>* The GPs will ensure maintenance and cleanliness of Anganwadi toilets.</li> <li>* Importance of hygiene to be discussed in the Schools and Anganwadis.</li> <li>* Adequate soap availability in Schools and Anganwadis to be ensured.</li> <li>* Cleaning of kitchen for Mid-Day Meal and nutrition for Anganwadis.</li> <li>* During the Day the Blocks/ GPs with the support of the education department will hold Sanitation Awareness Walks/ Rallies by School Children with Slogans/ Banners within the community/ villages (Focus on S&amp;LWM, ODF, Sustainability, Removal of Plastic waste etc.</li> <li>* In addition the Schools could also organize Slogan Competition, Essay Competition, and Debates etc. at School Level (Focus on Environment cleanliness).</li> <li>* Use of School Children and NSS (High School) incleanliness drive in Schools and surroundings areas will also be made.</li> <li>* During the Day Toilet Cleaning will also be carried out in all Schools.</li> <li>* Provision of drinking water, hand washing facility and water facility near School &amp; Anganwadi toilets</li> </ul>
17th November 2018	<b>Water Purification/ Cleaning of Water Bodies Day</b>	<p>PRIs, Youth Clubs/Mahila Mandals and other CBOs will be involved to clean all the traditional water sources with the support of I&amp;PH deptt. After which, I&amp;PH department will ensure chlorination of all water sources including drinking water tanks of each school/ institutions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Mass campaign for water testing would be initiated by I&amp;PH deptt.</li> <li>* Cleaning of Water bodies, Hand pumps, tank bunds, Bore well platforms as well as other water sources.</li> <li>* Cleaning of water tanks, overhead water reservoirs including chlorination.</li> <li>* Testing of quality of water from each source may also be undertaken. Sources of contamination and pollution of water sources should be stalled.</li> </ul>
18th November 2018	<b>Sanitation Technology day in under SLWM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Effective mechanism for SLWM activities will be established in the GPs.</li> <li>* Support of the Agriculture/ Horticulture departments</li> </ul>

		<p>would be sought to organize special camps for the promotion of the Household/Community level composting for management of SLWM.</p> <p>* General discussion of Sanitation Status of the GP and discussion on Future Action Plan with special focus on SLWM and Sustainability.</p> <p>* Promotion of low cost technological options in respect of CSCs and SLWM projects.</p> <p>* Supporting the area of Suburban Gram Panchayats and tourist centric points for effective SLWM mechanism .</p>
