Sir/Madam,

We are aware that the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) was set up by the Government of India in 2005 to ensure that children's rights are protected and to address the rights violations. The NCPCR has been instrumental in the development of the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCSE) in 2020.

During this time, amidst the COVID-19 pandemic when the schools have been closed and the safety of children's online education is under threat, it is essential to provide learning opportunities. The MHRD Order No. 40-3/2020-DHR (dated 20.03.2020) provides for the use of digital content and encourages online education. Though schools are providing education through digital means, NCPCR has been receiving various representations from states regarding the quality of content that may be used to bridge the gap of non-formal education and the safety of children.

In this regard, it is stated that the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has developed the Academic Workflow under section 29(1) of the RTE Act, 2009. The Academic Workflow is a set of guidelines for the schools to follow. It includes the use of digital content and encourages online education. The guidelines also mention that the content should be age-appropriate and should be of high quality.
