Dear

There has been a massive upsurge both in the number of Covid-19 positive cases as well as deaths attributed to this virus in the last 2-3 weeks. This surge in infection is a matter of grave concern at the Government level and effective preventive steps are required to be implemented at the ground level. Social distancing, mandatory covering of face in public areas, personal hygiene (especially hand hygiene), sanitisation of all public areas continue to be the most effective preventive measures to contain the spread of this virus. Besides this, timely testing, immediate contact tracing, isolation and strict enforcement of the containment zones / places is absolutely critical to break the chain of infection. In recent times, a lot of cases have been attributed to primary contacts, which in some level reflect easing up on the above strategy of immediate contact tracing tests, isolation and containment by the field agencies. The core principles of this virus containment strategy referred to above need to be disseminated widely to all stakeholders, whether it is a shopkeeper, a hotelier, restaurateur, a cab or a bus driver, a street side vendor, public official, office bearers of PWS and ULBs, the self help groups etc.

You are also aware that SOPs have been issued by different departments of the Government to guide the officials as well as the general public about various measures to prevent and contain the spread of virus. However, as emphasised by the earlier vide D.C. letter dated 0th November, 2020, these SOPs need to be strictly enforced and monitored. Violators of these SOPs must face the consequences for violating the provisions of these SOPs, whether it is a temporary closure of establishment or a pecuniary fine or a legal proceeding.

The Hon'ble P.M. has also given a clarion call for taking preventive steps to contain the spread of virus. There is an urgent need to disseminate this message through a widespread IEC campaign, using all possible communication channels. We must launch a campaign to encourage people to

take a pledge to wear face mask, sanitise their hands, maintain social distancing in public places, avoid public interaction in case of fever, cough, breathing problem etc. and to immediately consult the Doctor, honestly follow quarantine and isolation guidelines, undertake to notify the authorities truthfully about their primary contacts in case of a covid positive result etc. We can use the media, local body officials, trade Organisations/ Associations, community / religious leaders to propagate the need for taking such a pledge and honestly fulfilling the pledge. A clear, unambiguous message should also go into the society that social / community / religious gatherings should be few and attendance in such functions kept to the minimal so as to contain the spread of virus. Collectively if we resolve to follow basic precautions there is no reason why the rate of infection and the fatality cannot be brought down considerably

I hope you will provide necessary leadership to your District in meeting this challenge.
