Coverage of students under Mid Day Meal scheme in the State.

Sir/Madam,

It is to inform you that while examining the district wise coverage of students in primary (classes I-V) and upper primary (classes VI-VIII) under MDMS, as per QPR data for the quarter ending 30/06/2017 it appears that still out of the total enrolled students 6 % students are not being covered under the aforesaid scheme in the State, which indicates that either these 6 % students are not attending the schools regularly or remain absent from the school. The district wise detail of the coverage of students under MDMS as per QPR data for the quarter ending 30/06/2017 is as under:-


