

PROCEEDINGS OF MEETING HELD ON 4TH APRIL, 2018 AT 02.30 PM HELD UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF DR DAISY THAKUR, HON'BLE CHAIRPERSON, HP STATE COMMISSION FOR WOMEN, SHIMLA (HP) ON VARIOUS ISSUES.

At the outset of the meeting the Member Secretary welcomed all the participants and started discussion as per agenda items. List of participants is attached at Annexure – "A".

Item No.I: Installation of Sanitary Napkin Dispenser Machines and Incinerators in various institutions.

During discussions, the Director of Health and Family Welfare, Himachal Pradesh informed that the sanitary napkins are being distributed through Asha Workers to the girls upto the age of 18 years. However, it was resolved that:-

- a) The Department of Health Services and HP State Commission for Women will take up the matter with the Government for implementation of this scheme in all Universities, Colleges and other educational Institutions. Further the Department will also initiate process for rate contract for napkins, dispenser machines and incinerators.
- b) The Department of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, HP, Women & Child Development, Health Services, Education and Information & Public Relations will launch a joint campaign for use of sanitary napkins and making awareness in the society so as to sensitize the masses. They will install Sanitary Napkin Dispenser Machines and Incinerators in one or two institutions in very District as model unit.

It was further decided that the Departments of Industries, Labour & Employment will jointly evolve a strategy for implementing above schemes in Private Industries/ Factories and other Institutions. They will also try to get these under CSR Activity so that funds for machines and incinerators be provided to Govt. institutions at local/ district level.

Action by: RD&PR., WCD. Health Services, Education, Industries, L&E. BOCW, Women Commission, DME. & IPR.

Item No.II Mass Awareness Programmes to curb the vice regarding women staying outside their houses during periods in some parts of the State.

The item was discussed in detail and it was resolved that the Departments of Health & Family Welfare, Women & Child Development, Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Higher Education, Elementary Education and Information & Public Relations will jointly launch targeted awareness campaign in specific areas where this evil exists.

Action by: Health, RD&PR. WCD., Education, & IPR.

Item No.III Registration of NGOs.

The Member Secretary of the Commission apprised the participants that the District Programme Officers (ICDS) have been requested to send the list of NGOs working in their respective District but the same is still awaited. It was resolved to take up the matter with the Director, Women and Child Development Department, HP.
