Sir,

You are, therefore, requested to direct all the heads of educational Institutions(Private & Government to contact nearby PECs/ LMKs to enroll the leftover students studying in schools(Private & Government) and ensure complete coverage of the age group 5-18 years by 31st March, 2016. The list of students mentioning their Aadhaar Numbers will also

be required to be submitted by the LMKs on the attached proforma (for maintaining Register in schools.)

Dear Abhishek,

As you are aware that the State of Himachal Pradesh is one of the leading states in Aadhaar coverage in the country. As per the census data Aadhaar have been generated for 99.28% residents in the State as per census. However as per current population the Aadhaar coverage is 93.87% in the State. The Prime Minister's Office (PMO) has instructed all the State Governments to complete the Aadhaar enrollments by 31st March 2016 and the same is being reviewed in monthly 'PRAGATI' meeting chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. The following strategies have been devised for 100% coverage in your District.

As the Major Gap in your District is with Children in **0-5 years** and this needs to be covered through Anganwaris, Department of IT with the help of Women and Child Development department has already started the Training, Certification and Onboarding process of the Anganwari workers. 100 Tablets will be deployed in the District. For the effective utilization of these tablets, District Administration should finalize the tablet movement plan to cover each and every Anganwari. The Proforma for certifying the Anganwari coverage and the number of enrolments done in a particular Anganwari is attached as **Annexure "A"**.

For **5-18 years** age group, your district is very close to saturation and for the leftover population it is suggested that list can be prepared by District Education Officer (with the help of School Administration) and Permanent Enrolment Centres can be moved to identified schools for enrolment of left out children. Permanent Enrolment Centres set up by the LMKs (Lok Mitra Kendra) can also be utilized for this purpose and can be remunerated @Rs 200 Per school, subject to the declaration signed by the Principal mentioning that 100% Aadhaar coverage has been done for that school. The list of students mentioning their Aadhaar Number will also be required to be submitted by the LMK. (Proforma is attached)

District Administration can utilize the funds for these activities from the funds already given from Aadhaar to District E-Governance Society. If these funds have been utilized, more funds can be provided on submission of the utilisation certificate.

You are, therefore, requested to please deploy the enrolment kits in the field as per the requirement and closely monitor the progress so that the target of 100% Aadhaar coverage can be achieved by 31st March 2016. You are also requested to assign one SPOC (Single Point of Contact) for your district for effective coordination with Department of IT. The progress review will be done every fortnight.
