The Guide teacher should help and ensure innovational perception to awardees.
- No readymade models/exhibits will be entertained. Emphasizes should be given on creativity and innovations. General layout of the model, its relevance, clarity of charts accompanying and overall alignment to theme will be assessed.
- This year 326 students (LIST ENCLOSED) have been selected for INSPIRE awards of Rs 5000/-each which are being credited directly into their respective accounts .
- All the Heads are again being directed to inform the undersigned office in case of non credit of amount within 3 days by email to dnoinspire@rediffmail.com so that DST may be intimated timely.
- The participation of all awardees is compulsory and excuse of non crediting amount will not be accepted. The amount awarded to participant, if not still credited will be credited soon.
