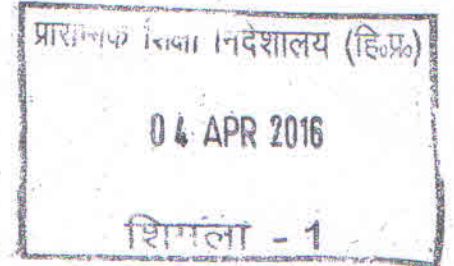

Allocation of free food grains (Rice) for the 1st Quarter (01-04-2016 to 30-06-2016) under the National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for Primary and Upper Primary Schools (Primary 19711.30 quintals & Upper Primary 21693.30 quintals) for the year 2016-17.

Sir,

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Elementary Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan New Delhi-110001, vide their letter No. 5 -1 / 2016 – Desk (MDM) of dated 02.04.2016 has conveyed the allocation of foodgrains (rice) for Primary Stage (classes I - V) and Upper Primary Stage (classes VI - VIII) for the 1st Quarter (01-04-2016 to 30-06-2016) for the financial year 2016-17.

In is regard, it is informed that 19711.30 quintals of rice for Primary stage and 21693.30 quintals of rice for Upper Primary stage is being allocated on the basis of enrollment of of 30-09-2015 as per enclosed ANNEXURE-1.

While lifting the rice, it should be ensured that the best quality foodgrains, which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality FAQ, is lifted form the PDS Depot. The process followed at the time of receipt of foodgrains from FCI Depots should be repeated at each level till the foodgrains reach the end user to ensure that only good quality foodgrains is delivered for consumption by children. Records /samples regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.

In view of above, it is requested that distribution of rice to the Blocks as per norms i.e. 100 gms. per child per day in respect of Primary classes and 150 gms. per child per day for Upper Primary classes be made.

It is also informed that the balance of rice from the previous quarter/ year may be kept in view while allocating rice to the Blocks for providing Mid Day Meal under MDM Scheme.

Before making allocation the following points may be considered:-

- 1) Enrollment of Block / institution
- 2) Number of school days
- 3) Approved norms 100 gms. Primary classes and 150 gms. for Upper Primary classes per child per day .
- 4) Unutilized Rice lying with the school/ Block.

(Enrollment of Block/ School * No. of Schools Days in the Quarter/ Month * approved food norms) - Unutilized Rice lying with the Block/ Schools)

- To ensure the timely supply of Rice, allocation of rice to Blocks/ schools should be made on Quarterly basis instead of monthly basis.

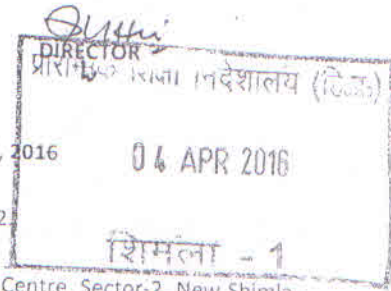
