UIDAI has offered solution to State Government and Residents regarding difficulties being faced in seeding of Aadhaar number in beneficiary databases on account of non - receipt of Aadhaar letter or loss of EID/UID by resident like download e-Aadhaar, advance search, Mobile/E-mail based EID/UID search facility etc.

Dear

As you are aware that 95.85 Crore Aadhaar has been generated and in respect of adult population Aadhaar saturation has crossed over 90%. An exercise has been undertaken by Ministry and States Government to seed Aadhaar in beneficiaries' databases of MGNREGA, PDS, NSAP, Pension, LPG, Provident Fund. However, it has been brought to our notice by the State Governments that difficulties are being faced by them in seeding of Aadhaar numbers in beneficiary databases on account of non-receipt of Aadhaar letter or loss of EID/UID by the resident in many cases.

2. In order to overcome aforesaid difficulties being faced by residents/States in seeding of Aadhaar number in beneficiary database, UIDAI has offered following solutions:

For Residents

- UIDAI has provided facility to download e-Aadhaar on its portal for the resident by providing enrolment ID.
- Biometric and demographic based advance search facility has been provided in the enrolment client in the field. Resident can visit any of the enrolment centers or Common Service Centres and download their e-Aadhaar by giving his EID or certain demographic detail in case he has lost his EID/UID.
- Mobile/E-mail based EID/UID search facility has also been provided on resident portal for the resident who had given mobile/E-mail during Aadhaar enrolment.

For State

- Advance Search:** UIDAI has offered to give advance search facility to State officials for a limited period of three months to enable them to seed Aadhaar in cases where a resident has lost their EID/UID or have not received Aadhaar letter. The State may send the request for creation of login credential for Advance Search Facility for their field officers, to respective UIDAI regional offices. Regional offices have been empowered to grant the advance search facility to field officers of State Government.
