Sir,



The objective of the campaign is to ensure that street children are brought into the mainstream by inclusion in the formal education system.

You are, therefore requested kindly to inform whether any survey to work out the number of street children has been conducted by any Govt./Private organization or not. If affirmative, the number of street children in your District may kindly be intimated to this Commission. If not, the survey may be got conducted through the local authorities and a consolidated report may kindly be sent to this Commission.

The comments to initiate this campaign without identifying the exact number of street children and its relevance in the present scenario may also be furnished please.
