RULES AND REGULATIONS

Introduction:

- The objective of the Science Seminar is to inculcate a spirit of scientific enquiry and analytical thinking in the minds of young students. The Science Seminar will be held on a competitive basis in each State and Union Territory.
- Only one winner from each State/Union Territory is eligible for National level Competition, which will be organized online by Birla Industrial & Technological Museum, Kolkata on 20th January 2022.

Participants: High School Students from class VIII to Class X only

Language: English, Hindi or any recognized Indian language.

Mode

(National Level): ONLINE Live session (previously sent recorded presentation may be judged in case of disruption of live presentation for any reason, upon **State Coordinator** and **Judges' discretion**).

Duration: Participants shall make his/her presentation on the given topic for a maximum duration of **6 minutes using supplementary visuals or presentation as per rule**. The participant may be assisted by one teacher during presentation for use of visuals only. This will be followed by a two minute Question-Answer Session with the Judges on the same topic.

Norms for State Level Science Seminar: -----

1. Only one participant per school can join as through & certified by school.
2. **Participants shall send write ups of his/her presentation either typed or legibly hand written on A4 Size paper.**
3. The Committee for Science Activities at SCERT will scrutinize the received write-ups and the shortlisted candidates will be invited through a letter from SCERT to participate in State level Science Seminar
4. The shortlisted candidates shall send video of his/her presentation on the given topic for a maximum duration of 6 minutes using supplementary visuals (without using any written script) where presenter & presentation/visuals should be clearly visible and he/she should be clearly audible.
5. Power Point presentation / images of Chart used in visuals and prerecorded video of entire presentation to be sent before the competition. This recorded presentation may be judged in case of disruption of live presentation for any reason (upon State Coordinator and Judges' discretion).
6. There will be an online multiple choice test through Google Sheet for all the participants before the presentation starts.
7. After each deliberation, each participant will be asked 3 (three) questions by the judges and the participant will be required to answer any 2 questions asked in two minutes.
8. Each participant will be given digital participation certificate.
9. Only one winner from each State will join Online National Level Seminar (due on 20th January 2022). Each participant will be given digital participation certificates.
10. **Supplementary Visuals:** The maximum number of supporting visuals / slides / charts etc. permitted per participant is altogether 5 (five only). The details of these are as given below: -----
 - a) Charts / Posters - maximum size permitted is 850 mm (width) x 600 mm (height). All charts / posters are to be mounted one on top of the other, as done in a calendar. One side of the chart / poster is considered as one unit. There should be no pop-ups.
 - OR
 - b) Computer based slides Static (Office 2007 / Office 2010 .ppsx & .pptx format) without additional features like animation, pop-ups, rollovers, etc.
No interaction within one slide is permitted.

- **3D models, videos and films are not allowed to be shown during the deliberation / presentation.**
- **Uninterrupted internet connectivity, sufficient lighting, working audio-system, representation delivery via Google Meet or similar platform, on Desktop PC with webcam / Laptop is to be ensured.**
