Dear Maam/Sir,

As you may be aware, the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) is the largest open schooling system in the world, and it comprises a national level Examination Board setup under this Ministry by the Government of India.

NIOS is vested with the mandate to offer academic programs upto pre-degree level which includes Secondary, Senior Secondary and Vocational Education through open and distance learning mode to learners. NIOS operates through a network of twenty three (23) Regional Centres, two (2) Sub-Regional Centres, two (2) NIOS cells and about seven thousand study Centres in India and abroad.

NIOS conducts two Public Examinations at the school level during March-April and October-November and issues certificates to its learners. These certificates are recognised across the country for the purpose of pursuing higher studies as well as employment in Government, private undertaking and Public sector. As NIOS provides huge opportunities with flexibility, this will help learners who have not been able to complete their formal school education for any reason, to achieve their life aspirations.

In this backdrop, I request you to issue necessary instructions to all concerned authorities in the State, including Departments of School Education, Higher Education, Adult Education, Social Justice and Empowerment, Women and Child, Skill development and Entrepreneurship, Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Urban development, Tribal affairs, Minority affairs, Labour and Employment, Sports and Youth Affairs, etc. to promote NIOS and to encourage the dropout students to avail different programs of NIOS through Open & Distance Learning (ODL) mode so that they may complete their schooling for a better future. For admission purposes, interested persons may visit the website of NIOS i.e. www.nios.ac.in and/or contact the NIOS Regional Centre in the State/UT.

I will be grateful for your co-operation and personal intervention in the interest of the students of your State/UT. I look forward to a response regarding action taken in this regard.
