Various pedagogical processes, which make learning an enriching experience (project-work based on small action research, interactive sessions, group learning/discussion etc.) , leads in developing creativity, critical thinking, communication skills, confidence etc. The learners should be able to contribute towards problem solving and nation building by learning, thinking, and applying these skills at work.

Accordingly, The Principals and Headmasters of the schools are directed to take timely actions to adapt to above said pedagogical processes as much as feasible, in the present scenario.

The question papers, for second term assessment, will be shared in the same pattern as in first term assessment and will be prepared at the State level, by the State Resource Group. The syllabus /revision completed through Har Ghar Pathshala, upto 30th November will be covered.

The areas, where there is no internet facility or the students do not have smart phones, the Principals and Heads will take all the decisions at their own level, regarding syllabus to be covered, printing of papers, the duration to attempt the same and submission and checking of answer sheets etc.

Schools where there are no subject teachers will be facilitated by the Deputy Director Higher Education by assigning the task of executing the assessment to the teachers of adjoining schools.
