Ability to read motivates students to read independently, develop vocabulary and express better in oral or written communication. This skill is a basic building block for developing creativity and inculcating critical thinking in young learners. The contribution of reading in improving learning outcomes has been demonstrated in various research studies.

Honouring the father the 'Library Movement in Kerala', the late Sri. P.N. Panicker, the State Government of Kerala has been celebrating 19<sup>th</sup> June as the 'Day of Reading' and the following week as the 'Reading Week' since 1996. This initiative commenced in collaboration with the P.N. Panicker Foundation, paved the way for the launch of Reading Mission 2022. In furtherance of the lofty objectives of this Mission, the Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurated the 22<sup>nd</sup> National level Reading Day and Reading Month celebrations at Kochi on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

This year, during the closing ceremony of Reading Mission-2022 a variety of events will be organized in hybrid mode in Schools/Colleges/Libraries by the P.N. Panicker Foundation which will include wide range of activities such as organization of seminar/symposia/workshops; organization of quiz, elocution, essay writing competitions; organization of mass run with the slogan 'Reading for Empowerment', campaign with a slogan 'Donate a Book'; and organize libraries with people's participation; street plays to inculcate reading habit; folk arts depicting reading for growth and magic shows highlighting reading for empowerment.
