Recently, NCAER had done a study under the scholarship scheme of M/o Minority Affairs (MoMA). On physical verification of 1752 institutions by NCAER, from 22 States, 830 institutions were found either fake, non-operational, or the students had fraudulently claimed scholarship from these Institutes. In view of the above, this Ministry has assigned a study to NCAER for physical verification of the institutes and beneficiaries in respect of Pre-Matric and Post-Matric scholarship Schemes of MOIA being implemented by the States/UTs.

2. NCAER teams are likely to visit the States/UTs very soon. You are requested to instruct the concerned district/field level officers to extend all cooperation like accompany of the concern official(s) with the visiting team of NCAER, co-ordination with the institute and NCAER team etc. in respect of above work assigned to them. The details of NCAER team officials will be shared by NCAER shortly.


